We are off to a great start to a fun and growing year! Everyone is getting familiar and comfortable with our daily routines.

Although your child may not bring home papers daily, we consider everything we do during the day a learning experience. We will paint, color, play in the sandbox, draw on the chalkboard (with chalk and water), play with play dough, and of course, go to the bathroom a lot! Please continue to help your child learn to pull down his/her own pants in the bathroom and to pull them up again. Dressing them in elastic waist shorts or simple dresses will help them to be independent and "do it themselves!"

Our curriculum "In the Beginning" is based on the creation story in Genesis. Each month will have a different theme and all parts of instruction (art, music, science, etc.) will fit together under this theme. The September theme is Day 1 of Creation. The theme for this month is "Into His Marvelous Light." We will learn about Day 1 of God's creation when He created day and night, light and dark. We also will continue familiarizing the children with some shapes and colors. The spiritual emphasis is on God's almighty power, and obedience is our response to Him. Our slogan this month is "The happy way is to obey."
